
Iraq Situation Report: July 29, 2014



ISIS continued to challenge the Peshmerga near Sinjar, although these are not major operations and do not demonstrate a desire to control Sinjar. Instead, ISIS could be testing the defenses of the Peshmerga. The targeting of the bridge that connects Samarra and Tikrit was likely done in order to prevent ISF reinforcements from Balad, an area currently reported to be reinforced by volunteers, to Tikrit. Udhaim was cleared by the ISF and Iraqi Shi'a militias in June. The launch of the current clearing operation indicates that ISF has not been fully successful in maintaining its control over the area. ISW therefore currently considers Udhaim to be contested.
