Genevieve Casagrande is a Syria Research Analyst at the Institute for the Study of War where she focuses on the Syrian opposition as well as Russia's increasing involvement in that country, particularly its airstrikes campaign. She previously worked with the Carter Center as a Conflict Analyst with the Conflict Resolution Program's Syria Conflict Mapping Project and the Syria Transition Options Initiative.

While at ISW, Ms. Casagrande has spearheaded ISW's nearly 40 Russian airstrikes maps which have appeared in major publications across the globe.
