Jan 30: Pro-Opposition Residents Launch Anti-Conscription Campaign in Southern 5 Jan 23 - 24: IS Likely Expanding Operations in Turkish-Controlled Syria: Local residents reportedly affiliated with former opposition groups launched a campaign Northern Aleppo Province: The Free Police backed by Turkey detained five alleged against conscription by pro-government forces entitled "Do Not Join the Ranks of the Criminal Army" Islamic State (IS) militants in Azaz in Northern Aleppo Province on the Syrian-Turkish in Daraa City in Southern Syria. HTS released a statement blaming the attack on the Islamic State (IS). IS denied any involvement in the blast.
